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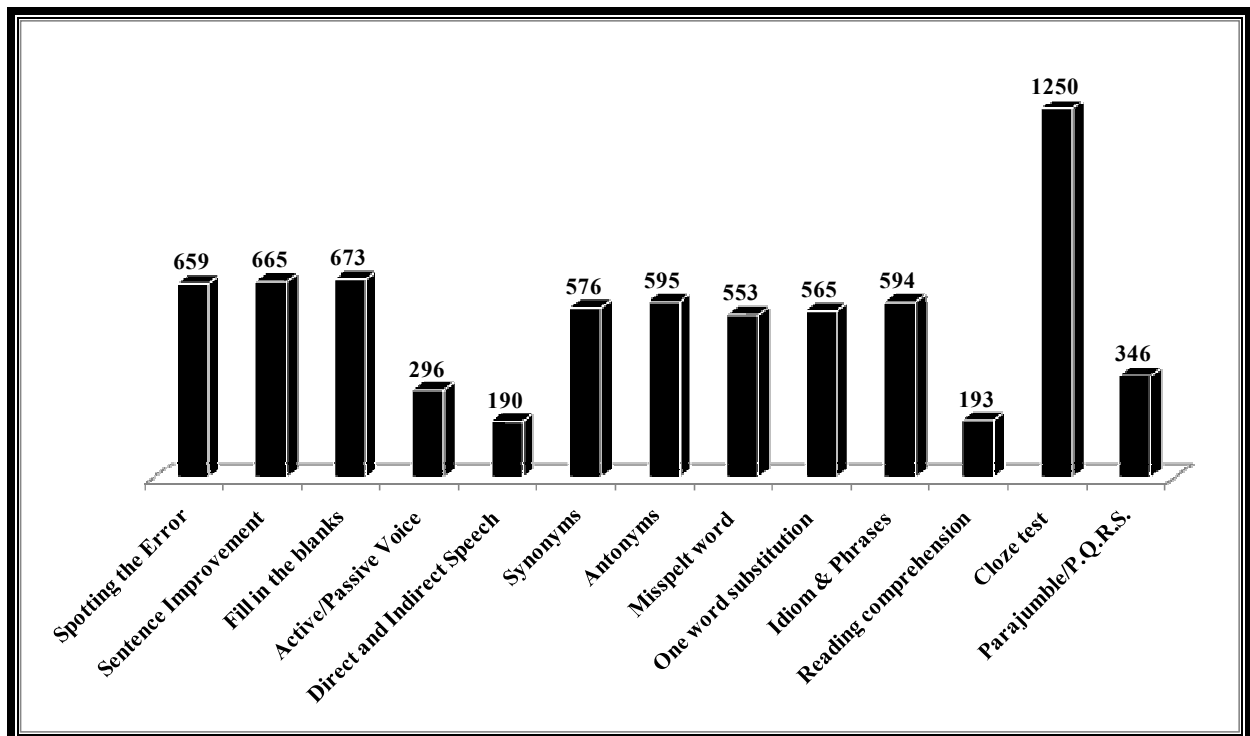
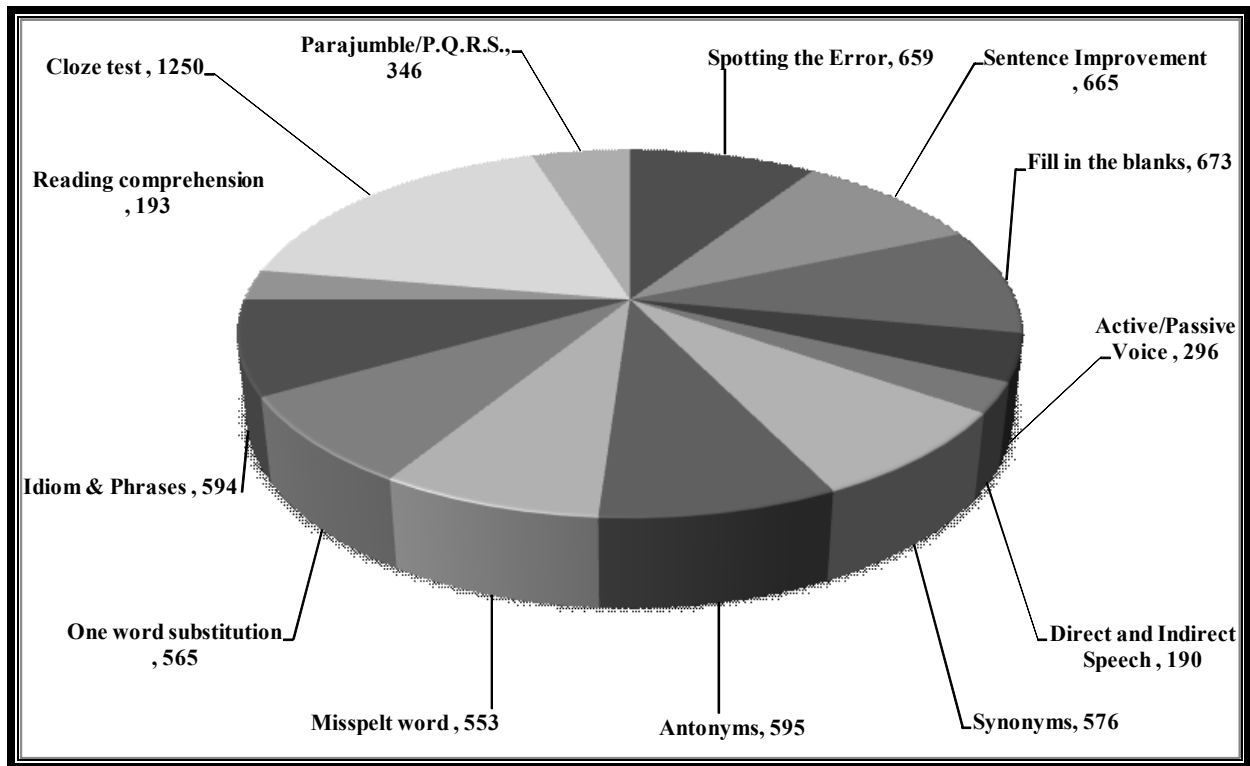

Trend Analysis of Previous Year SSC English Papers Through Pie Chart and Bar Graph



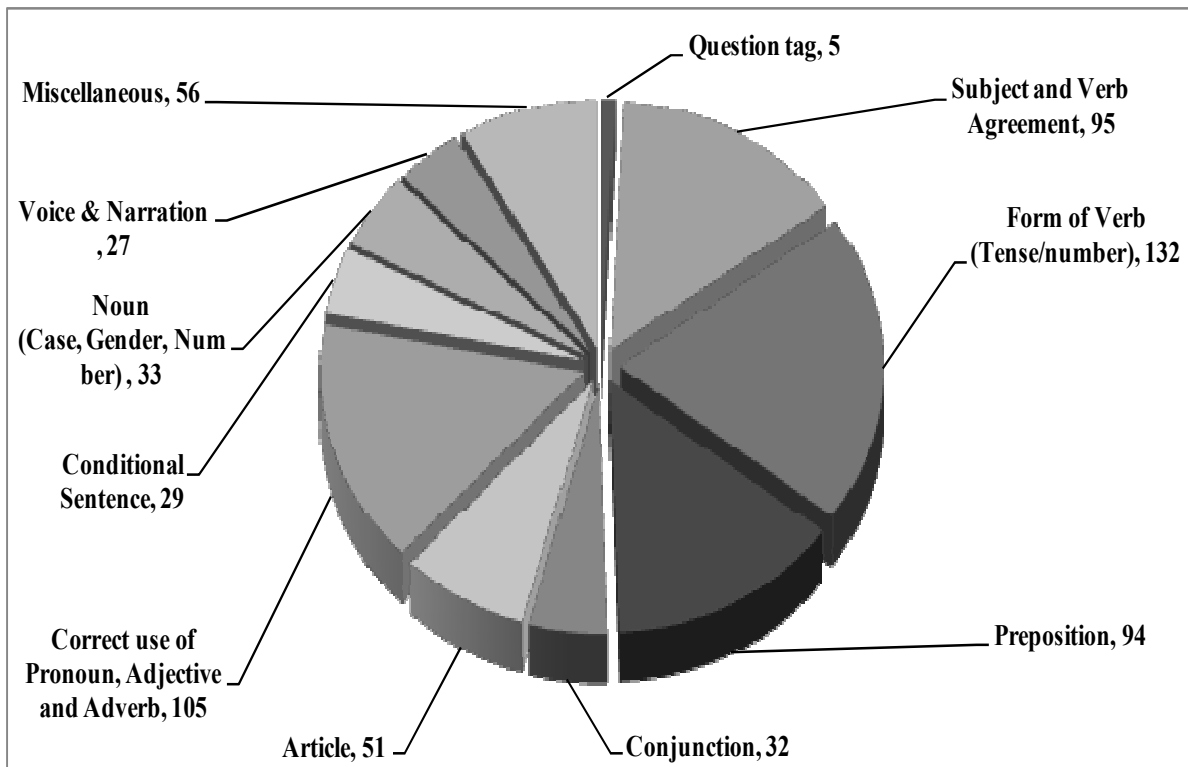
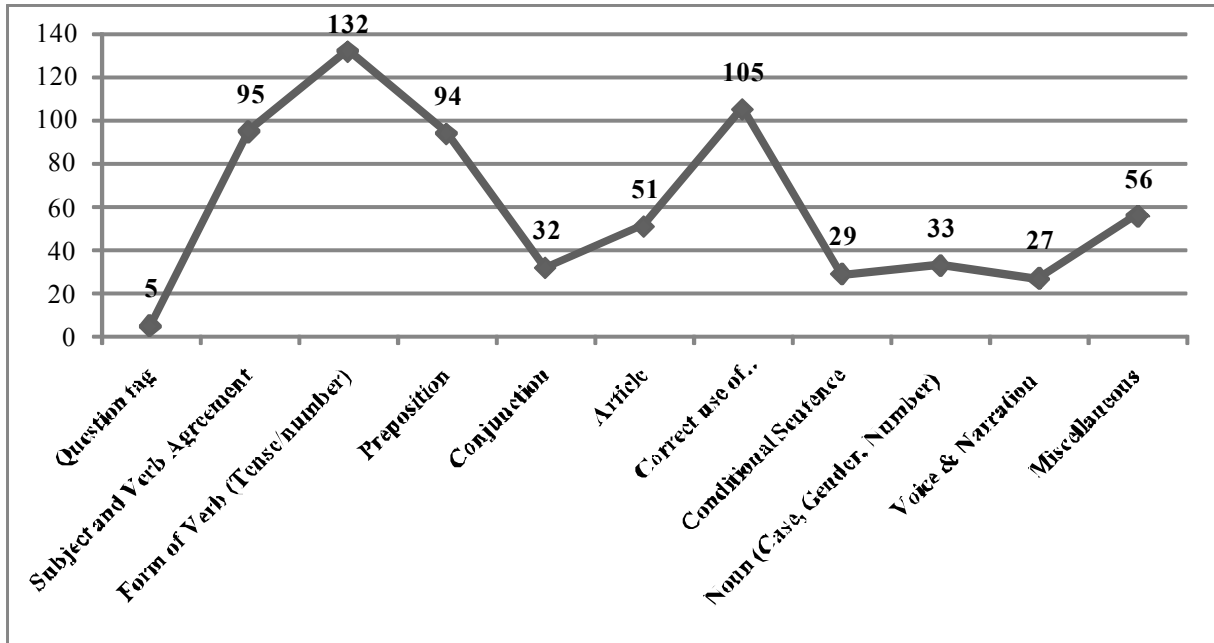
